



Acworth Baseball Association – Senior Division Post-Season Tournament Rules

updated 6/24/2014

The post-season tournament is a blind draw, double-elimination tournament, unless otherwise stated. The regular season rules will be followed, with the following exceptions/clarifications:

PITCHING

The innings pitched count starts new for all players when the tournament begins. A 13/14 YO player is allowed to pitch no more than 12 innings for the entire tournament. A 15-19 YO player is allowed to pitch no more than 18 innings for the entire tournament. There is no innings pitch limit **per week** during the tournament.

Calculating Innings Pitched

Every out earned by a pitcher counts as 1/3 of an inning. Additionally, 1/3 inning will be counted if at least one pitch is made towards another batter (or batters) without an out being recorded. For example, if a pitcher gets one out, walks two batters, and is then pulled, 2/3 of an inning is to be counted towards that pitcher. If the second pitcher records the final 2 outs, 2/3 of an inning will be counted towards the second pitcher. It is therefore possible that the innings counted towards pitching may not equal the actual number of defensive innings in a game.

Logging Pitching

The official scorekeeper logs innings pitched. **BE SURE TO SIGN THE PITCHING LOG AFTER THE GAME.** If you fail to sign it, the league director or another board member will sign it for you, making it official.

RUNS SCORED

There is no run limit per inning.
